1. Reynolds Drove Byway – Surface upgrade, **benefits all users**

2. Western Park Public Bridleway - Surface upgrade, **benefits all users**

3. A1307 NMU route (new) – Tarmac path, **benefits all users**
2021 works completed by National Highways
4. Bar Hill NMU bridge over A14 (new) – **benefits all users**
2021 works completed by National Highways
5. Wilson's Road Bridge (new) – Bridge over Southern Access Road West, **benefits all users**
Approx. Completion – July 2022, works by Homes England
6. B1050 Bar Hill (new) – Path link from Bar Hill to South Access Road West, **benefits Pedestrians/cyclist** Approx. Completion – 2021 section completed by National Highways, July 2022 works by Homes England
7. Southern Access Road West (new) – Path link from Bar Hill to Northstowe Town Centre, **benefits Pedestrian/cyclist**. Approx. Completion – April 2022 works by Homes England
8. B1050 roundabout to Home Farm Road (new) – Path link Bar Hill to Longstanton, **benefits Pedestrian/cyclist**. Approx. Completion – TBC, works by Cambridgeshire County Council
9. Wilson's Road Public Bridleway south side, from bridge to A1307 – resurfaced, **benefits all users**
2021 works completed by Cambridgeshire County Council (Funded by National Highways)
10. Wilson's Road Public Bridleway north side from bridge to Longstanton – resurfacing, **benefits all users**. Approx. Completion – TBC, works by Homes England/Cambridgeshire County Council
11. Longstanton Road (also known as Airfield Road), Longstanton to Oakington, **benefits all users**
Approx. Completion – July 2022, works by Homes England. Please note: all motorised vehicles are prohibited, farm access is available.
12. Rampton Drift Byway – Longstanton and Rampton Drift path to Guided Busway, **benefits all users**. Approx. Completion – July 2022, works by Homes England.
13. Northstowe Phase 2 and 3A (new) - Perimeter Bridleway, **benefits all users**
Approx. Completion – to be determined as part of condition, works by Homes England
14. Northstowe Phase 3B (new) – Bridleway link Longstanton to Guided Busway, **benefits all users**
Approx. Completion – to be determined as part of condition, works by Homes England
15. Guided Busway crossing from between Reynolds Drove (1) and Rampton Drift Byway (12), surface and lighting improvements, **benefits all users note: cyclists required to dismount as no drop curb possible on this section**. Approx. Completion – TBC, works by Cambridgeshire County Council
16. Longstanton Park & Ride connection (new), path link to Water Parks, **benefits Pedestrians/cyclist**. Approx. Completion – TBC, works by Cambridgeshire County Council
