## Northstowe CDOs Report for April 2024

## Northstowe Community Forum – New Venue

The next Forum will be on Wednesday 8 May at the Western Park Pavilion in Northstowe. The drop-in session will start at 6:30pm and the presentations at 7pm. We are liaising with the presenters and setting up meetings for the Forum. We have been working with the Communications Team and distribution company for the flyers, which will be delivered to all residents to promote the new venue. New Forum sound/projector equipment has been purchased, which we have been testing. We will be asking for questions and sending out emails with the agenda once confirmed.

#### Raised Beds at The Cabin

We have been working with Northstowe Hub and Northstowe Horticultural Association to run a gardening workshop where the community and Youth Hive were invited to design the planting for the two raised beds in the back garden. We are hoping to have the planting session at the end of May, weather dependant.

#### Menopause Café

We have been working with residents and health care professionals to start a Menopause Group in Northstowe. The first Menopause Meeting will take place at the Cabin on Wednesday 24 April starting at 6pm. It will mainly be a 'Get together group' but will hopefully have guest speakers at a later date. The sessions are free and will be run monthly.

### Midsummer Festival 22 June 2024

Preparations for the Midsummer Festival are under way, this will take place on The Green, it's an event for the whole community. We are supporting Northstowe Arts and Northstowe Hub with preparations, there is participation from many other groups.
