## CDO's report for September 2024

## Northstowe Community Forums 2024

The last Forum was held on Wednesday 11 September at Western Park Pavilion. It was well attended. For the first time, the forum was hybrid and we successfully broadcast live on Microsoft Teams. Feedback from residents informed that it worked well and the audio was clear. We are now starting preparations for the next Community Forum on 4 December.

#### The Northstowe Running Festival

We had a very good morning helping as marshals for the 10K and Half Marathon, although Lottie, one of our dogs, would have preferred to be in the race rather than being an assistant.

<u>Engaging New and Emerging Communities Conference</u>, we are helping organise a partnership event with colleagues from Cambridge City Council and Cambridgeshire County Council, and the developers Urban & Civic, which takes place on Saturday 5 October. The lead speaker is Cormac Russell from Nurture Development. The invitees include planners, developers, urban designers, landscape architects, youth engagement officers and community development officers.

## Proactive Neighbourhoods

This is a programme designed for South Cambs, ran by the NHS and aimed at people who are frequent users of the services. It aims to look at preventative measures before the person reaches their threshold. Most professionals can make a referral and cases are then discussed collectively and considered by various professionals during a monthly Multi Agency Forum (MAF). The project is only in the beginning, however people referred so far are benefiting from a personalised care approach. We have recently referred a Northstowe resident and they are currently receiving multi agency support adapted to their needs.

#### **Digital Buddies**

Following the initial Digital Buddies drop-in session on 12 July, a further session took place on 18 September. These were provided by the Citizens Advice during the Food Bank sessions. Connecting Cambridgeshire are also supporting the project and had a drop-in session on 18 September 10:30am-1:30pm to find out what local residents need in regards to digital support. The sessions are designed to offer digital assistance such as: using/downloading apps, searching information online, bus pass application. We are working towards establishing regular Digital Assistance sessions, however volunteers will be needed to run the sessions, all training will be provided.

#### Junior Bowls

Thanks to the Kickstart Fund from Homes England, the Longstanton and Northstowe Bowls Club have had some fun sessions with juniors and family members. The lawn is now being prepared for next season which starts in April 2025.

## Menopause Meetings

The Menopause Group meetings are free and take place monthly on a Wednesday evening. The guest speaker for the meeting on 25 September is Ingrid from Midlife360. She will be talking about supporting women returning to work and changing job roles whilst experiencing menopause symptoms. Future meetings will be advertised on Northstowe Facebook pages and community Noticeboards. Please contact us if you would like to help run the group.

## Community Activation Grant Fund
