6.0	Maintenance and Management Update – Greenbelt	
6.1	Greenbelt's Update	
	 Couple of thefts of shrubs from the local square Graffiti has been removed from several bins and street lighting. Same tagger. Awy reminded the group that Cambridge City Council provided support to removal graffiti previously. Junior Parkrun is planned to start in September – October and a site walk was conducted with them. An exact starting date needs to be provided. H8 - soil and seeding done. BDW paid Greenbelt to water the seeding. Once the area has taken Greenbelt will invoice residents. H9 - legal engrossment taken place and waiting for the agreement to be signed by BDW. Littering in the Kingfisher Pond – have removed as many items from the pond as possible.

	 Given that so much time has passed, and we have already had a very large dry spell some trees may have already 	
	suffered.

	Conversations can resume in the autumn regarding next
