TITLE OF MOTION	Purchase of Santa Outfit and Bins For Light Up Northstowe 2024		
MOTION(S)	To approve the purchase of a Santa Outfit and 4 Black Bins for the 2024 Light Up Northstowe Event		
Background	This year's Northstowe Christmas Switch-On event takes place on Saturday 23rd November 2024. Various organisations, including Northstowe Council are involved, with Northstowe Arts leading on the event management and delivery.  The Town Council had previously agreed (Sep 2022) to supply a Christmas tree with decorations, as was done in previous years. The Town Council has also granted Northstowe Arts a total of £2,930 towards the cost of the event (Finance and Governance Committee 16th July 2024, item 32/24-25.  In Northstowe Community Networkers meetings about the Light Up Northstowe event a wish has been expressed for the Town Council to support with a Santa and bins, as the Town Council did in 2023 when it led on the LUN 23 event.  Santa's Outfit: We currently have one which had been adopted by us in 2024. The Santa's presence was popular and well received by residents, we specially by those with families.		
	However the outfit could do with being updated, as it is of poor quality. With a much bigger event expected this year would be good to have a higher- quality outfit for the Santa (being sourced – resident volunteer).		
	Black Bins - In 2023 we borrowed a couple of large black for the Christmas Light Switch-on event from Longstanton Parish Council as we did not have any.  > These proved very useful at the event.
