#### 1. Midsummer Festival

- Mari had previously shared a report evaluating the Midsummer Festival.
   Any further feedback to be shared with Mari. Northstowe Arts/Hub looking at repeating Midsummer festival next year 21 June 2025, potentially extending the timings 12-8pm. This will increase the programme without needing additional space.
- Location to be considered: Conclusion between Northstowe Arts and Hub is that having a visible location (on The Green) for this event is more important than more space. Willingham Wolves will be holding their annual tournament during the morning. Next year they are looking at having more of a community angle. Aim is for the organisations to help promote each other's event rather than combine. Willingham Wolves event will enable a sport focus with Midsummer Festival more of an art focus.
- A discussion was had about funding, Northstowe Arts received no donations and Northstowe Hub only received a very small amount. There is limited understanding with the community of how much these events cost Mari hoping to publish a small report which would include some of the costings.
- Will be seeking business sponsorship to support next year's event.

Volunteers – could have done with some more stewards – thinking how we
incentivise in the future – potentially through a food van voucher. Will liaise
with the uniformed services for next year.

## 2. Light Up Northstowe 23 November

- Plan is for a similar event to 2 years ago. The lantern parade will finish at
  The Green ready for the light switch on. Prime Brass will lead the parade.
   Lantern workshops will be held in weeks building up to the event.
- Working with NTC/Foodies/Northstowe Hub. NTC organising the tree,
   Foodies organising food vans and Northstowe Hub will run the café and looking at offering a free offer, probably hot chocolate again.
- There will be a raised cover stage, professional sound and lighting –
   school choirs/bands will perform. Action: EC to share proposed location
   with colleagues given the construction of the community building.
- Sustainable Northstowe will hold a toy swap in The Cabin and NA are also looking at having a small ecofriendly market – will be putting a call out for ecofriendly local makers.
- Pathfinder Church hope to launch the maps of the advent window. EC encouraged Pathfinder Church to contact Western Park Pavilion. Alex at Tap and Social very keen to have a window too.
