Dear Mark

We have not produced a report for January as we have no updates to give over and above the last report, given the holiday period. The only item to note is the ongoing work on the B1050 but we have posted extensively on Social Media and I copy below for reference:

UPDATE: B1050 – Tie in with new South Access Road West – temporary lights

We have caught up with Sisk, Homes England and Cambridgeshire County Council (CCC) highways officers this morning, following reports from the residents yesterday.

Please note:

- This is the first few days of the lights going up, so Sisk will be refining their traffic management systems accordingly
- Lights are manned remotely from a van, you will not necessarily see a person at the lights
- Priorities will be given in the morning peak from Longstanton and from Bar Hill in the afternoon/evening peak
- Please use as much of the road space as possible approaching the roadworks from A14
- Waiting time should be no longer than 8-10mins, anything more please do report on email to Homes England: [northstowe2@homesengland.gov.uk](mailto:northstowe2@homesengland.gov.uk), this email is manned daily.

Through OneNetwork CCC Officers can monitor and analyse traffic disruptions.

CCC Officers will be inspecting the site today to ensure that all conditions are being met.

The following conditions have been attached to their Street Works permit:

- Manual control of the traffic lights is required between the following times: 06:30 – 10:00 and 14:30 – 19:00; and
- Removal of the traffic lights as soon as possible and within 4 hours of the works being completed.

Lighting: Temporary lighting will only be installed when the traffic is moved onto the new carriageway alignment.

Cycle path: unfortunately, due to B1050 limited road width, no temporary cycle path can be set up, cyclists will need to use the road alongside cars.

One full weekend closure in late February / early March 2022 from Friday 20:00hrs – Monday 05:00hrs will be required to complete the final surface course, road markings and traffic signs – the date for this is to be agreed with Cambridgeshire County Council Permit team in due course.
