## Background to Co-option of a Town Councillor for Northstowe TC

In January 2022, one of the Northstowe Town Councillors resigned, triggering a procedure to attract a new Councillor, to fill the resulting casual vacancy through co-option.

During the period 21<sup>st</sup> January to 14<sup>th</sup> February 2022 the casual vacancy was advertised through the Town Council's website (<u>news item</u>), shared on Facebook – including on a number of Northstowe-focused Facebook groups - and Twitter, and advertised as small posters on the noticeboard at The Green and on the railings in front of the Pathfinder Primary School, with Councillors and partners also sharing this opportunity wider through their respective networks.

As a result, the Town Council has received a number of enquiries, resulting in five application forms received before the deadline of 14<sup>th</sup> February. Initial checks have been made on eligibility and, based on the information supplied by the applicants, all are deemed eligible to stand for co-option.
