The volunteers will receive access to a training platform managed by Connecting Cambridgeshire.

Northstowe Table Tennis Group

Working with Northstowe Table Tennis to support their initial sessions in 2025 at Northstowe Education Centre. The first sessions took place on Monday 13 January and Saturday 18 January, both were very successful with adults and families participating. Future sessions will take place on Monday evenings at 7pm and Saturday mornings at 10am.
