## Northstowe Community Forums 2024

The next forum will be held on Wednesday 5 March at Western Park Pavilion. It will be offered as a hybrid meeting, broadcast live on Microsoft Teams. Flyers were delivered to all residents w/c 17 February.

#### Community Networkers

The Northstowe Community Networkers Group met on Wednesday 12 February, the agenda included LEL (London Edinburgh London) cycle ride, which has a checkpoint in Northstowe, African Heritage Group, Midsummer Festival and community group diary dates. ### New Defibrillator at The Cabin

We had a defibrillator donated by the developers which has now been installed inside The Cabin. It is in the storage room attached to the wall between the storage room door to the kitchen and storage room door to assembly room 1. It is important to mention that while the storage room is not locked, this can only be accessed when The Cabin is open. The box where the defib is stored is not locked like the other outdoor devices so it can be accessed by anyone without the need to call the emergency services to provide a code to unlock. People should still call 999 in an emergency to be provided with the appropriate advice. This information will be added in the next Northstowe News as an update to all residents.

# **Digital Assistance**

The digital sessions now take place on the second Friday of each month at the same time as the Mobile Library. The sessions were advertised on the back of the Community Forum flyers and were delivered to all Northstowe residents. The volunteers are accessing a training platform managed by Connecting Cambridgeshire.

## Let's Cook

We worked with Let's Cook to arrange three sessions over the February half term holiday for primary school aged children. The sessions will look at nutrition, meal planning, preparation and cooking.

## Northstowe Table Tennis Group

We have been supporting this group with some of their Monday sessions 7pm – 9pm. The group has also provided coaching and the use of a table tennis robot. On Saturday mornings there is a session more suitable for families and beginners at 10am.

#### Drama Group

We supported the set-up of a new Amateur Dramatics group which will fall under the umbrella of Northstowe Arts. The group will meet every Thursday 7-8:30pm with their first show at the Midsummer Festival in June.

# Menopause Support Group Meetings

The Menopause Group meetings are free and take place monthly on a Wednesday evening. The meeting in February was about skin care. The next meeting on Wednesday 19 March will be looking at menopause and art; resilience and energy. Future meetings will be advertised on Northstowe Facebook pages and community Noticeboards.
