An adult

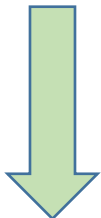
A person aged 18 and over who needs care and support.

A member of staff, manager, volunteer, contractor, agency worker.

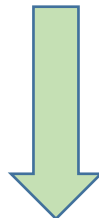
IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS IN IMMEDIATE DANGER, DIAL 999 WITHOUT DELAY

If the danger is not immediate, then take the following action:



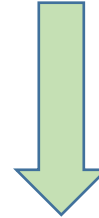
