## Northstowe Community Forums 2024

The next forum will be on Wednesday 4 June at Western Park Pavilion starting with a drop-in at 6:30pm and presentations at 7pm. #### Community Networkers

There was no Community Networkers' meeting in March as there was a Forum. The next meeting will be on Wednesday 2 April, a week earlier than normal due to the school holidays.

## **Digital Assistance**

The digital sessions now take place on the second Friday of each month at the same time as the Mobile Library. Northstowe residents who are unemployed or of pension age will receive a text message to let them know about the support available. The next session will take place on Friday 4 April.

#### Northstowe Table Tennis Group

We have been working with this group to discuss future dates and places. Sessions in April will continue on a Monday evenings with a new time from 7pm – 8:30pm. The Saturday morning sessions will not run after the end of March.

# Tree Planting

We joined Sustainable Northstowe on 8 March for a Tree Planting event at the Pioneer Park. It was a great day out planting fruit trees which residents had the opportunity to adopt and will look after until maturing.

# **Drama Group**

We are supporting the new Amateur Dramatics group through their application for the Kickstart fund. The group meets every Thursday 7-8:30pm to prepare for their first show at the Midsummer Festival in June.

## Menopause Support Group Meetings

The menopause group meetings are free and take place monthly on a Wednesday evening. The meeting on Wednesday 19 March looked at menopause and art; resilience and energy. In April, the meeting will be based around chocolate. Future meetings will be advertised on Northstowe Facebook pages and community noticeboards.

# Social Walking Group

The CDOs have been supporting the walks. The walk on Friday 14 March included a rock painting session, these will be used at a family Easter painted rock hunt starting at The Cabin on Saturday 12 April at 2:30pm. Future walking dates, routes and themes will be advertised on the Northstowe Community Facebook pages and the noticeboards at The Cabin and Western Park Pavilion.

#### **Drop-In Session with the CDOs**

We offer monthly drop-in sessions for residents, usually on the first Tuesday of the month. No appointment needed, pop in for a chat over a cup of tea at The Cabin, in the café area. We are also available if residents would like to set up a meeting, whether this is within working hours or not. Most people drop in on an ad-hoc basis and we are always happy to make time to see them.

#### Community Activation Grant Fund

SCDC are administering the Northstowe Community Activation Grant Fund on behalf of Homes England. This month applications have been received from Hindu Samaj Northstowe for their Holi Mela event in April and Northstowe Hub for the Midsummer Festival in June. The panel are currently considering the applications.
