Dear Parish Councils / Residents Associations

We have just published on our website a report that includes a new Greater Cambridge housing trajectory and our five year housing land supply calculations for the new five year period:

The housing trajectory shows anticipated delivery of new homes across Cambridge and South Cambridgeshire up to 2041.

The report also demonstrates that jointly for Greater Cambridge (Cambridge and South Cambridgeshire together) we have 6.1 years of housing land supply for the 2023-2028 five-year period. This conclusion is based on our five-year housing land supply being calculated jointly, using the Liverpool methodology, and applying a 5% buffer.

Attached is a briefing note that provides the answers to some common questions relating to the housing trajectory and five year housing land supply calculations.
