3.1	Kissing gate	
	 AWy/TP informed the group that following a conversation with colleagues at County the path is not where it should be hence the kissing gate looks in the wrong position currently. Peter Gaskin (Public rights of way) is now liasing with the Parish Clerk.

- RW informed that there is no update on quotes for the works required.
- 4G Inspection
- The 4G was required to be be inspected for matches to take place.
 SCDC previously arranged an inspection but Football Foundation would not accept this. A new inspection has now been undertaken.
 Proposed that this is paid for out of the escrow account initially.
 Future inspections will be paid by the operator. Agreed by the group.
- Street Lights:
- The cap over the lamp posts hasn't been fitted properly and water goes in when it rains so this needs to be fixed.
- L&Q have stated they are beyond the contractual period with the Main Contractor (who employed the lighting contractor) who constructed the Local Centre Square and they do not have any recourse under the terms of the original contract.
- EC will enquire with L&Q to see if there is any other way, otherwise proposed to use the escrow account. Agreed by the group.

5.0 Maintenance and Management Update – Greenbelt

- NTC has enquired which power sockets Greenbelt are paying for as they are not indicated on the plan included within their bills. Greenbelt confirmed they are responsible for the power sockets on The Green which they are managing. RW to confirm to MN. The power sockets will be indicated on a map going forward.
- Next step is to review the Western Park electricity connections as these still seem to be with Greenbelt.
- The monthly report will be updated and sent over this week.
- MM asked for more detail to be added on the bill breakdown.
- EC clarified that the Escrow account was used for the seeding for the Western Park grass pitches.
- EC stated that NTC have asked that once additional work is identified can Greenbelt will bring it to the Open Spaces meeting to be approved before carrying out the work. RW happy to do this.
- MM advised that an explanation was requested on why plants are repeatedly planted every year. RW explained that young planting cannot always survive and then we were also hit by a very dry season and then a cold snap.
- LH informed that Homes England would like to have the lessons learnt to avoid the same issues in Phase 2. She recommends that this is put in the procurement document and advises that tree planting is done earlier in the season, also
