Our vision for Northstowe is a town with community activities and facilities at its heart, supported by an active and integrated network of groups and organisations; bringing people of all ages and backgrounds together to address isolation and provide equality of opportunity.

Foundation Model CIO Charitable Objectives:

- To further or benefit the residents of Northstowe and the surrounding area, without distinction of sex, sexual orientation, race or of political, religious or other opinions by associating together the said residents and the local authorities, voluntary and other organisations in a common effort to provide facilities and organise activities in the interests of social welfare for recreation and leisure time occupation with the objective of improving the conditions of life for the residents. Activities

- Meeting with and lobbying local authorities to secure funding and provision for community space, both temporary and permanent, in Northstowe.
- Involvement in creating and implementing a management system for the community space
 which provides a clear and straightforward pathway for local residents and groups to use
 these facilities, and regularly reviewing this system to ensure that it is meeting these aims.
- Canvasing a wide cross section of local residents to ascertain the social requirements of the community, including any disadvantages they may be experiencing, and formulating action plans to address these needs.
- Increasing the awareness in the local community of the groups and activities which are available to them, using both physical and virtual media - including placing notices in the existing community newsletter Northstowe News, distributing posters and flyers around the community, sharing information on social media, and coordinating with current community websites.
- Supporting local community groups and projects by providing information, contacts and resources.
- Coordinating events to raise the profile of groups and organisations active in the community.
