### Timetable

Planning permission received and programme updated. QC had produced a list of key dates but would check/update to see if there are any programme changes.

Follow-up – the programme has slipped by 3-4 weeks and an updated 'key dates' sheet is attached.

#### **Communications/Publicity**

QC had discussed with CCC comms. It was agreed that a press release about the facility was now appropriate, but that it would be better to wait until after the May 5 local elections. Proctor and Matthews (Architects) also wanted to put something in technical journals about the project but agreed this would be simultaneous with other publicity.

It was agreed that 8 October could be a suitable opening date.

Update: the construction programme slippage means that a soft opening in September is not possible but that the 8 October (7 Sqdn Assn weekend) was achievable. Simon Hill (Vidar Media – exhibition designer) has advised that the Royal Anglian Regiment Museum are interested in the project as the regiment was based there in the 1980s and as a result it may be possible to invite the RAR Regimental Band. There are also connections with the current 7 Squadron RAF that can be explored.

Agreed that we need a name for the facility!

Agreed that a timelapse video of the construction would be beneficial. QC has raised with Homes England and has details of the person that undertook theirs. Construction PM to action.
