#### Northstowe Community Forums 2024

#### **Climate Action**

We are organising a training session on Climate Action which will be delivered by the Climate and Environment Team at South Cambs on 8 July. This is supported by Sustainable Northstowe. At the end of the workshop participants will have to come out with pledges to support sustainability. A separate workshop will be organised for a local artist to support participants to create an art piece out of the pledges.

#### <u>60+ Group</u>

The group has met four times in the café area at The Cabin (community centre on Pathfinder Way). The social gatherings are open to all local residents aged 60 and over. The July sessions will be advertised on community noticeboards and on local Facebook pages.
