- Park Play is a charity which has been operational for 3 years. It was initially delayed due to Covid.
- It aims to help communities to create their own Park Play event through play.
- It takes place every Saturday. The launching event is Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> May 10:30am at the Western Park and it is an introduction for residents to gain understanding on how to get involved. Information will be provided regarding the play leader role and how residents can become part of the team.

- No experience necessary, full support and training will be available
- Funding was provided via Living Sport and Homes England through the s106
- Free fun informal for all ages. For and by the local community
- Residents do not need to bring anything, all games and app access for play ideas is provided as well as DBS checks
- At least 1 play leader will need to be available every Saturday
- After the introductory session on Saturday, there will be at least a couple of months before kick-off
- All encouraged to spread the word in the community
- It is inclusive for people with various degrees of disabilities and the organisers are committed to provide training for Play Leaders to support with the adequate knowledge. Firouz suggested reaching out to Power to Inspire and see if John would be interested in supporting.
- The CDOs will be on hand supporting the launch
- Marcin will be in touch with the organisers regarding the Running Festival on 2<sup>nd</sup>
  September so the two events can run alongside each other
- 2. <u>Cultural Exchange Café</u> event on 1<sup>st</sup> June: Firouz and Natalie will run a Cultural Map event around communication styles from different cultural backgrounds. This will be a fun and inclusive event, all welcome. It will take place from 6:30pm 8pm at Northstowe Secondary College during The Community Lounge session. A poster will be shared on social media soon.
- There are also plans for the faith groups to organise an event later in the year
- The Cultural Exchange Café is open to all groups to organise events on relevant cultural topics, please get in touch with Mihaela if you have an idea you'd like to discuss
- 3. <u>Northstowe Events Calendar</u> will be populated soon. If you are unable to access the calendar, please email the communities team for assistance.
- 4. **Northstowe Day** suggestion from SCDC is to wait until September.
- Northstowe Hub will offer all community groups the chance to get involved with a stall and activities from 3pm on a weekend day in September after the Running Festival
- A community quiz will run in the evening with food vans coming along
- 5. <u>Car Boot Sale</u> 20<sup>th</sup> May at Northstowe Secondary College in the car park area from 10am-2pm

- So far, 17 pitches have been booked by residents from Northstowe and nearby villages
- There will also be a parent run barbeque, second hand book sale, hand made cake stall run by parents and students, coffee van
- There have been requests for community stalls from Stardust and Cristina Freniche
- Potentially there will be a second-hand uniform stall with voluntary donations
- Swavesey guides will come to assist on the day, however more adult volunteers are needed
- The school will be shut and all activities will run outdoors, if the weather will be bad, it will be cancelled.
- Outdoor toilets are available

Northstowe Day/Temporary Community Centre opening event

Northstowe Arts would very much like to play a part in this day. We would like to put on an exhibition of the artwork created for the wrap of the building, and offer a Creative Get-Togethers session – probably bring-your-own-project – if this fits with everyone else's plans? Could potentially do a singing group session and/or jazz jamming session too/instead if people would like and the leaders are available.

<u>Sustainable Northstowe</u> are getting ready for the Great Big Green Week 10<sup>th</sup> -18<sup>th</sup> June where there will be litter picking, workshops, talks, wellbeing walks and much more

- On 17<sup>th</sup> June a Community Action Day will be celebrated on The Green where skips will be provided for residents to recycle wood, metal etc. These have been funded by BPHA. All are encouraged to come along and have a look around the 'take it or leave it' stall in case there is something they'd like to rescue from going in the skips. There will be seed swaps, the community larder food, the clothes swap rail. Northstowe Arts and BPHA will deliver a free workshop for residents to create something new out of recycled materials. This is also supported by the CDOs who will be on hand for a chat on the day.
