

## **Phase 1 Open Space Steering Group Management and Maintenance**

The below information is a short compilation of main actions stemming from the meeting (for which the Clerk has been given permission to distil from official minutes).

**Report for: Northstowe Town Council, Full Council meeting, 22 September 2021**

### **Notes and actions – Summary of key points:**

- No objections raised by residents directly overlooking LEAP 1 in the northern greenway for the preferred site for relocation of the table tennis tables – Actions SCDC with L&Q
- Intra-parcel green spaces to be transferred into the ownership of Greenbelt. Community engagement events planned for residents in first parcels – Town Council asked to be involved – Actions Greenbelt with L&Q.
- Kingfisher Pond: Weekly inspection results to be reported on through new Open Spaces Management and Maintenance monthly Report (started August 2021), also in light of recent issues including anti-social behaviour and concerns over pond management raised by residents. Greenbelt commented on lack of clarity on remediation actions going forward. Actions L&Q with Greenbelt.
- Waterpark and Northern Greenway now opened. Press release on 6 September – Action SCDC.
- Cycle path linkage Park and Ride with Waterpark – CCC working on drawings and costs – Action CCC with L&Q.
- Cycle path connection SE corner waterpark to Rampton Road/busway – solution being looked at – Action CCC with Homes England.
- Loose gravel on northern greenway paths reported – L&Q to investigate – Action L&Q.
- Water Park and greenways: concerns over prickly weeds – Greenbelt to investigate – Action Greenbelt.
