### Contact your local council

- For instances of littering, missed bin collections etc
- For minor traffic, road and parking issues
- To address noise complaints from within a property
- To report uncontrolled dogs
- To report busking (if it is causing disruption)



### Go online

- In non-emergency situations where you still require advice or assistance
- If you want to provide us with intel about crime happening in your area
- If you're not comfortable on the phone
- If you'd like advice, guidance or reassurance on an incident, but you don't want to call 999 or 101



### Call 999

- If a serious offence is in progress or has just happened
- If someone is in immediate danger
- If property is or is likely to be damaged
- If you suspect a serious disruption to the public is likely
