Responding to Current Affairs

Homes for Ukraine

- One of the local councils with the highest number of arrivals and therefore hosts
- 408 hosts have welcomed 787 guests: 914 DBS checks have been completed and 405 welfare visits made
- In our ward, Longstanton currently (17.04.23) has 11 Ukrainian guests, Oakington & Westwick have 2, and Northstowe has 3.
- SCDC is still looking for hosts: duty.communities@scambs.gov.uk

Cost of Living Support

- Low-cost methods of warmth: 300 residents given electric blankets, slow cookers
- Funding: Housing, council tax discounts, warm hub programme incl. £200k recently
- Supporting the vulnerable information on support available
- Warm hubs becoming wellbeing hubs



By- Election November 2022

- Handover from Clirs Alex Malyon & Sarah Cheung Johnson
- Support from Cllr Firouz Thompson (county), Cllr Bill Handley (SCDC)
- Support from the Parish Councils and the Town Council
- > Discovery & Action: matters of concern raised by residents in the election campaign
- Case work: noise; planning; bins; ASB, etc. (confidential)



1. Public Transport

GCP 'Making Connections' consultation:

- Sustainable Travel Zone
- Processing 24k responses
- Some key concerns emerging Addenbrookes, tradesmen making multiple journeys, potential weekly expense for low income
- 2 representatives from SCDC on the GCP
- Final report on the proposals due June 2023
- Recommendation will then be made to the County Council <u>as to whether to</u> <u>proceed</u>



GCP Making Connections

- New bus routes, additional orbital and express services to key sites across the city, and a huge increase in services for villages and towns across the travel to work area.
- Buses supported by flexible services known as Demand Responsive Transport (DRT) – which you can book that picks you up from near your home, such as the popular Ting service currently being trialled in West Huntingdonshire.
- Longer operating hours from 5am to 1am and more frequent services - 6-8 buses every hour in the city and from market towns, and hourly rural buses.
- Flat fares to make public transport cheap and accessible for all; with passengers paying £1 to travel in the city and £2 in the travel to work area.
- Options for new cycling routes in the city and connections between villages and the wider active travel network, including the 12 Greenways routes.
- Improvements to public spaces to make Cambridge more 'people-centric'.
- All vehicle movements into, out of and within the proposed Sustainable Travel Zone (STZ) would pay a flat daily £5 charge between 7am and 7pm on weekdays.





2. Local Planning Across District

Economic Growth in Greater Cambridge: New jobs, new homes

- Government driven requiring all planning authorities to produce a local plan
- A 'carrot and stick' approach is adopted; local authorities that deliver the number of houses the government agrees are needed continue to have control over development planning. Those that don't, can lose the ability to decide what is built and where.
- SCDC is currently working to the Local Plan we inherited from the previous (Conservative) administration. Discussions are currently being held as to how the government's growth requirements can be delivered especially given the potentially serious consequences for water supply in the area without leaving us exposed to the 'stick'
- > Work on the next Local Plan is ongoing. The draft plan consultation is due in autumn 2023.



3. Longstanton: Groundwater

- Working with LEGG, Longstanton Parish Council, SCDC Planning
- Latest report following a CCTV survey is due to LEGG April/May
- Hypothesis emerging about how the issue might be resolved
- All parties involved are pleased with the progress and there will be information to share in the coming months
- Northstowe Town Council are being kept abreast of the process by Longstaton Parish Council



4. Oakington & Westwick: Environment

- Flooding mentioned often by residents during my campaign canvassing. Still in the discovery phase of my remit on this. Keen to support but need to understand more from residents before I know what support is required. SCDC Planning team are available and willing to support always.
- > Work of EAG impressed by the regular briefings and contact thank you
- 6 Trees planted by Parish Council supported on the day by SCDC Chair
- Greenway cycle path Oakington through Westwick to Cottenham fully support the PC comments and added safety comments to the consultation working with Cllr Firouz Thompson



5. Northstowe: Facilities

- Working with the Town Council and Delivery Group including SCDC Communities Team
- Aware that shops and a doctors surgery are top of the agenda for residents. These are planned for and will come.
