### 2024/25 - A Review

- June
  - Recruitment of Market Manager instigated.
  - Agreed to fund the Hope CIC Mobile Food Hub for a 24 week trial.
- July
  - Started recruitment of our Assets and Estates manager
  - Discussions on stewardship solutions given this recruitment with Homes England.
  - Approval of Recruitment of Market Manager
- September
  - Renewal of ParkPlay funding for a further 12 months.
  - Community Lounge funding bid submitted for support until October 2025.

### 2024/25 - A Review

- September (cont)
  - Discussed the name of the Permanent Community Centre (Unity Centre)
- October
  - Appointment of Assets and Estates Manager
  - Accepted funding to continue the Community Lounge until October 2025.
  - Councillor Resignation, and a Councillor Disqualification. Agreed to fill by co-option.
- November
  - Work on our bid for Unity Centre well underway.
  - Councillor Resignation. Agreed to fill by co-option
- December
  - Selected an IT Support service organisation to help us improve reliability and security of Town Council IT Assets.

### 2024/25 - A Review

- January
  - Councillor Co-option

- February
  - Submission of draft bid to operate Unity Centre to SCDC
  - Councillor Disqualification. Decided to fill by co-option.
  - Hope CIC Mobile Food Hub funding agreed to extend on a monthly rolling basis.
- March
  - Updates to Unity Centre Bid and revisions based upon feedback submitted
  - Councillor co-option, welcomed Cllr Hughes
- April
  - New Policies to support our bid for Unity Centre
  - Councillor Resignation.
