It was discussed that there are two different surveys and that it appeared that the Town Council had not yet gained access to the one created specifically for Town and Parish Councils. In addition, it looked like the public-facing survey is largely Cambridge City focused, and the Committee wondered whether the Town Council would be the right audience for that survey.

The **Clerk was tasked** to get back to the organisers of the survey and seek clarity on the above items, and to seek an understanding of the questions that have been prepared for Local Councils.
