Information:

- Loose gravel in Pioneer Park has been inspected again and no evidence of loose gravel that would cause issues in terms of safety.
- Greenbelt in the process of completing the standard reporting format specified in the Management and Maintenance Agreement.
- Hattons Road Ponds work continues on the process for adoption and transfer to the appropriate body.
- Cycling team continues to progress proposals to bring the s106 cycle/footway improvements which run along the frontage of the Hattons Roads Pond site.
- L&Q and County Council continue to progress discussions re. making a footpath link between the P&R and Waterpark.
- L&Q reported that grass establishment was good at the Waterpark and
 Northern Greenway. And an opening date 23 August is realistic.
- L&Q continue to work towards certification, focusing on Western Park, The Green, Pioneer Park.
- A detailed site proposal for Table Tennis Tables has now been shared with Open Space Steering Group and Town Council. Neighbouring households will now be informed.
- L&Q advised that the LEAP 3 Reserved Matters planning application would be submitted by the end of the month (August 2021).
- Sports Pavilion Reserved Matters applicated has been validated. Town
 Council to discuss at their next committee.
- Pre-App advice has been sought on the drainage remediation proposal for the allotment and orchard land. The views of the LLFA are also being sought on the proposals.
