Hope you are well and you had a great break.

Following feedback from the residents at the Northstowe Forum on 14 July, I would like to propose that Northstowe Town Council consider requesting Cambridgeshire County Council for advance funding and construction of the link between Longstanton Park and Ride and the waterparks within Northstowe. This is a short link that requires very little work and should be possible at a low cost. Please see map below circled in red.

This link will enable connectivity for use for leisure and travel to work. This will also be a safer route for pupils of Northstowe Secondary College and Martin Bacon Academy to travel to school, avoiding Stirling Road which is heavy with construction and school traffic. Safer alternative routes for pupils is essential as there has been a few near misses during drop off and pick up times at school.
